Cataract and glaucoma, combined or sequential surgery

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Cataract and glaucoma are globally the most common causes of blindness and the two eye diseases frequently coexist, but there is no consensus on the surgical management of coexisting cataract in patients who undergo glaucoma surgery.

This talk will be discussing the evidence for the IOP lowering effect and complication rates of combined procedures (cataract and IOP lowering surgery in one surgical setting) compared to these parameters of sequential surgery where cataract surgery is performed before or after an IOP lowering procedure.
